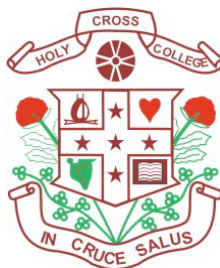


# Holy Cross College Ryde



## EXAMINATION RULES FOR SENIOR STUDENTS

It is the College's expectation that all senior students conduct themselves in an exemplary and serious manner during examinations.

In particular, the following rules apply:

- 1. Students must arrive to an examination 20 minutes before the scheduled start time.** A student who arrives late to an examination will not receive extra time beyond the scheduled finish time.
- 2. No student will be allowed to leave an examination before the scheduled finish time.** It is the College's expectation that students completing an examination early are to check their work during the remaining time.
- 3. Students must bring their equipment in a clear plastic sleeve into the examination centre.** Pencil cases will not be permitted in the examination centre.
- 4. Students are not permitted to bring mobile phones into the examination centre.**
- 5. Students must wear the College uniform to an examination.**
- 6. Students are not to talk in the examination centre other than with a supervising teacher.**
- 7. Students are not permitted to borrow items directly from another student during an examination.**
- 8. Students are not to deface question or answer papers with graffiti or unnecessary scribble.** A student whose paper is defaced in such a manner may be deemed as having made a non-serious attempt. This may incur a search by the Curriculum Coordinator of the student's papers in other courses attempted. Depending on the extent and severity, further action will be taken.
- 9. A student who is absent for one or more examinations must submit to the Studies Coordinator a medical certificate on the first day back at school.** Notification of absence to the Year Coordinator over the phone before an examination, although required, will not constitute a legitimate excuse.
- 10. MCS Representatives** must attend school on Thursday to fulfil their MCS sport Commitments.
